The Characters palette contains 19 famous people including kings, queens, religious leaders, explorers, inventors and writers. There is also a selection of modern day characters to enable students to create storyboards of interviews or TV documentaries and to comment from a modern perspective on the lives of those from history.

Taking one activity, Florence Nightingale as an example, children look at the story of Florence Nightingale before creating their own storyboard of her life. They can then test their knowledge of Florence before comparing her life with their own.
